Marc specializes in K-9 Team "problem solving", positive reinforcement training and stresses the importance of Training for Reality.

Steve Sprouse

has been in law enforcement for 26 years and a K-9 officer for 21 years. He is currently the trainer for the Broward County Sheriff's Office, located in South East Florida. Steve has been an FDLE certified canine instructor since 1993. He is a USPCA regional patrol dog and detection dog judge. In 1989, Steve was shot and seriously wounded in a K-9 deployment and has since been involved in the importance of training for reality.
